WHO? All current playing members (whether playing adult or youth hockey), parents and other interested members are requested to attend.

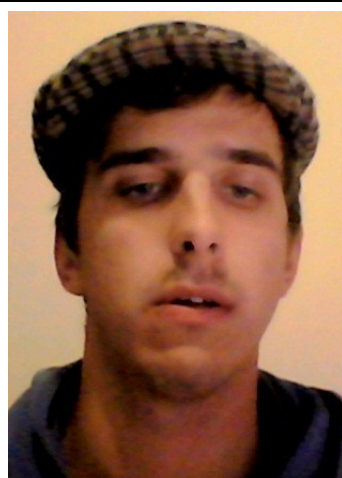
