His cack-handed style of hockey will remain a fond memory for some in the club, if not for all of his opponents! He was never slow to express a forthright view on club matters, but was always among the first to lend support whether by kind donations, speaking at the club dinner or in the early years of the youth section playing a cheery Father Christmas at the Christmas parties. He was a Mayor of Chelmsford, a long standing local councillor representing Broomfield and had the honour of being made a Freeman of the borough in recognition of his services to Chelmsford. He was of enormous help to the club when we planned the water based pitch and changing room extension and thereby played his part in securing the facilities we now have. Our thoughts go to his wife Joyce and family at this very sad time.

Delmas' funeral will be held at St Mary's Church, Broomfield on Wednesday 21st November at 1p.m. It is to be in the form of a celebration of his life, the family request that no mourning dress be worn and there be no flowers.
