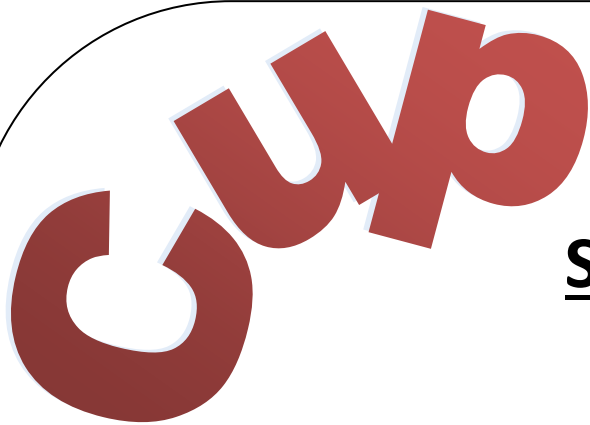


CHC QUIZ NIGHT
