Chelmsford Under-14 Girls secured qualification for the regional finals of the England Hockey U14 Championships with a deserved 2-1 win away at Broxbourne on Sunday. Despite knowing that they required a victory against the host club to progress in the competition, any early nerves were settled when Olivia Neave collected a pass from Alex Went after five minutes and calmly slotted the ball home. Although firmly in control of the game it wasn't until midway through the second half that Went extended Chelmsford's lead with a thumping finish after good work by Neave and Nicole Hull on the right flank. A late Broxbourne consolation goal against the run of play could have been the catalyst for some jitters but the girls responded sensibly and played out the remaining few minutes without further alarm.

Although they lost their final preliminary round match 6-0 to a powerful Southgate side later in the day, a game in which centre-back Lois Loucaides and goalkeeper Jenai Chindy excelled, the earlier victory secured the third and final qualification place from their group at the expense of St. Albans, Havering and Broxbourne. They now go forward, with group winners Old Loughtonians and runners-up Southgate to the regional finals on Saturday, 13th April where they will compete against teams from Surbiton, Teddington, Woking, Canterbury and East Grinstead for a place in the National Finals in May. The two pools for the regional finals will be hosted by Surbiton and Teddington, we'll find out in due course which venue we'll be at and the winner of each pool will qualify for the National Finals.

The team, selected from a squad of over thirty, has improved steadily this season and, as well as ten of the girls having recently been selected for the Essex U13 and U14 JAC squads, several of the older players are now also regular members of the senior club's 4th XI, which has undoubtedly helped their development. While they are firmly setting their sights on the National Finals another objective is to get many more of them playing in senior teams. After the matches, and despite being very cold and very wet, they surprised their Coach, Kitch, with a very impressive and tasty cake, made by Elona Woodford, to help celebrate his 42nd birthday. All in all a very good day!
