

- 3 Look for no breathing

compressions

Push chest hard and fast
Give 30 compressions



airway

Open airway with a head tilt chin lift



breathing

Give 2 breaths

Repeat sets of 30 compressions and 2 breaths

When the AED arrives, turn on and follow the prompts
