YOUTH GIRLS IN ACTION

It's a big weekend for the club's youth section in various knockout and national competitions.

First up are the Under-14 girls who, having come through a tough qualification group, have a long journey to Surbiton on Saturday to face the host club (14:00), Woking (15:50) and Canterbury (16:55) in the last thirty-two of the EH Girls' Club Championship. The opposition will be tough but the prize for victory in this tournament will be a place in the National Finals in May.

Although fully aware of the size of the task ahead, the girls are eagerly looking forward to pitching their skills against some of the best junior teams in the South of England. They have worked hard over the past few weeks in preparing for this tournament and, for the first time this season, are able to field a full strength squad. Boasting no fewer than ten girls who have recently been selected for the Essex JAC Under-13 and Under-14 squads, they need fear none of their opponents.

On Sunday it's the Under-18 Girls who have their chance of glory when they make the short trip to Old Loughtonians for their EH Plate Semi-final against Wakefield (10:00). Victory in that match would then pitch our girls against the winners of the other Semi-final – Oxford Hawks or Taunton Vale – in the Final at 15:00.

Also in action are the U10 Girls who will be at Redbridge Sports Centre all day for the Club In2Hockey Essex Mini County Championship, not only fighting for the honour of being crowned County Champions but also for a place in the East Finals of the National Championship.
