Your help is needed!!

As you are all aware CHC is run by volunteers, unfortunately it tends to be the same old (no age insult!) faces that do the jobs needed to keep our facilities up to scratch and keep our hospitality at a high level. So, below are a couple of pleas for your help! If they are something you feel you can help with even if it's only on a couple of occasions, then please get in touch with the relevant people.

Pitch Cleaning Rota - [Crawford McKee](#), our facilities manager is currently in the process of drawing up the new season's pitch cleaning rota in order to maintain the cleanliness of the water based pitch. For those that don't know this is a ride-on sweeper machine which is used once a week to ensure that the pitch is in the best condition for playing. All this requires is one hour of your time and full instructions will be given. The more people who volunteer, the less times everyone has to do it! We all know how much nicer it is to play on an algae free pitch (!) so if you can help then please get in touch with Crawf.

Club Steward - In order for the club to be open and ready to use for those on Saturdays, the club is looking for volunteers as "club steward" to work on a rota basis. They will be responsible for opening clubhouse, opening water pitch, water if necessary, turn on scoreboard, ensure ready for play, open sand pitch (if required), opening changing rooms, turn on hot water, opening link through to changing rooms, opening bar for soft drinks and be around to point players/oppositions in right direction and answer questions - again full instructions will be given and keys will be made available. It is not an onerous job but one which is very useful for the early teams so they can concentrate on playing. Timings wise, from around 30 mins before the first game to say 2pm.

The afternoon role involves the reverse of the above and runs from say 2pm to 6pm. If you are going to be around the club watching games then it is very easy to do this role - you don't have to be tied to the clubhouse/bar, so long as it is not left open and unmanned.
