



Junior Section Vacancies

Volunteers are sought to fill some key roles in the junior section of the club for the 2013/14 season.

None of the roles require any specialist hockey knowledge nor will they take up a great deal of time, but all are vital to the running of our club. If we can't fill them then important tasks simply won't get done!

Vacancies:

- ⇒ **Team Managers for U10 Girls, U16 Boys, U18 Boys** – responsible for general administrative tasks required to run these teams i.e. emails, phone calls, membership forms, liaison with coach, liaison with membership secretary, etc. This role must be great fun. Just look at how long some of our other managers have been in situ.
- ⇒ **Catering Manager** – required to coordinate the running of the clubhouse kitchen on Sunday mornings. Would suit somebody who prefers being warm and dry to standing by the side of the pitch throughout the winter months.
- ⇒ **Events Manager** – needed to organise junior tournaments hosted at Chelmer Park, typically 3-4 per season. The ideal candidate would be my wife because she enjoys telling other people what to do. Unfortunately, she's not available.
- ⇒ **Zevenbergen Tour Coordinator** – responsible for coordinating the army of volunteers required to host the Zevenbergen junior tour to Chelmsford in Spring 2014 and the organisation of the junior tour to Zevenbergen in Spring 2015. Would suit one of the freeloaders who enjoyed the visit to Zevenbergen last May.
- ⇒ **Kit/Equipment Manager** – responsible for coordinating the supply of kit/equipment to junior team managers and coaches i.e. playing kit, balls, cones, bibs, first aid kits, etc. Frankly, this is the easiest job of the lot. If you want to look important but like an easy life then this is the one for you.
- ⇒ **Communications Officer** – required to ensure club members, website visitors and media organisations are kept informed of junior news, information, events, etc. through website, newsletters, emails, etc. Don't apply for this unless you're comfortable using technology. Nerd required.
