## Break-in

The clubhouse was broken into in the small hours of last Sunday morning. Quite a bit of damage was done, though not much of value was stolen. Thanks particularly go to Brian Poole for spending several days this week getting repairs done and sorting out the insurance etc.

Some points:

- Please be vigilant around the clubhouse and changing rooms. Challenge, or ask a senior member to, anyone who is behaving suspiciously or has no right to be on our premises.
- The emergency exit double doors in the clubhouse are being temporarily chained together while we source more secure doors. If you are opening up or closing the clubhouse please remember the chains must be removed when the clubhouse is in use and put back as part of the locking-up process. The key is in the key cupboard labelled as "carpark key".
- More secure doors are being installed at the entry to the bar and the adjacent key cupboard. As part of an internal security review we need to confirm who holds a clubhouse key set (with or without a bar door key). **If you have a clubhouse key set please contact Janine Martin (07889 895413) IMMEDIATELY to confirm.** If you have a borrowed set in your possession you also need to contact Janine to confirm this and who normally holds them.
- So we have a comprehensive picture, if you hold or have a borrowed changing room and/or water pitch key, please report that also to Janine.

## CHC KIT

Well, we've had a busy few weeks running kit fitting sessions for seniors and juniors with many of you now kitted out or expecting delivery of your new, shiny Adidas kit. A few points:

- ⇒ We've had to return the skort samples as Lewes ladies require them and Adidas only provide one set per supplier! So it's try on a teammate's or ring InterSport Lewes to check sizes.
- ⇒ The hoodies, jackets and tracksuit pants are now on line. We still have some samples for you to try as necessary. If you would like to try them on please contact Spence, Jonny or Becca.
- ⇒ When confirming your sizes for all clothing please use the USA sizing on the label e.g. S, M, L not the UK sizing. If in doubt please ring InterSport Lewes.
- ⇒ We now have a club discount code "chc25" which can be used for hockey equipment but not clothing e.g. sticks, pads, shoes etc. Be aware that this provides a 25% discount off the RRP and in some instances this has already been partly or wholly applied to the prices you see online. So if you apply the code and it doesn't show up, it probably means that the item is already fully discounted. If in doubt check the RRP and have a word with InterSport Lewes.
