1) Bryan, thank you for joining us. Would we be right in thinking this is your first season playing as a forward?

Yes it is. Since I started playing hockey I have been in centre midfield or out on the wing. Through necessity I had to move to forward at the beginning of this season because I lost my best forward to the 2's. The rest as they say...

2) With such inspired form in front of goal and an 8 goal lead over the next highest scorer in the team, how come the move didn't come earlier in your playing career?

I would like to say it's because I was such a critical part of the midfield engine, but I think it is more down to me being a useful utility player. More often than not I have been asked to fill in the slots anywhere on the pitch, so, being a good team player, I obliged. Now having the captaincy meant I could give myself the opportunity which seems to have paid dividends.

3) A third of your goals came in one game this season, can we expect to see another hat-trick performance before the season is out?

I hope so. In the last few games, I have had a few quality opportunities, so if I can keep getting into the right places and getting shots away, I don't see why not. Plus any hat-trick scorer loves buying a jug for his team-mates, so I need to because I wouldn't want my teams throats to go dry.

4) You re-join the top 10 this week along with the Own Goal, a rule which has given your side 3 goals this season. As a newly discovered forward will you and your team be missing that rule when it disappears over the summer?

Yes and no. Yes because it has been kind to us this season and provided us with goals at some critical points in games which have turned them in our favour. And no, because as a newly discovered forward, forwards will be able to claim a few more of the deflections as their own instead of them going down as Own Goals.

5) Would you define yourself as a blaster from the top of the D or a deflection at the back post sort of goal scorer?

A bit of both really. I have had some lovely shots from the top of the D, but also a few deflections. But I will take a goal anyway it comes.

6) You've been a fixture of the top 20 goal scorers for most of the season, and this is the second time you've touched the edge of the top 10 and ensuing website fame. Where would you like to finish come the end of the season?

Top Spot. Why not? It's only a few goals away. Joking aside, anywhere in the top ten would be fantastic as it has been my first season playing as a forward. Also as I would like to move up the club so a top ten finish may help my case for progression through the teams.
