

Message from the Chair - Pitch Cleaning

The annual pitch clean will take place on 29th and 30th September and possibly 1st October depending on how much work needs to be done. As a consequence, no training will take place on the 29th and 30th. I'm sorry for interrupting training, but it is important that the pitch is not used whilst cleaning is in process. White lining and some seam repairs will take place after the cleaning is completed, but this should not interrupt training. Members should be aware that the cost of this work will be in the region of £4000 - a big cost to keep the pitch in shape. So it's all the more important that you continue to take care to stick to the paths to the pitch rather than cross the grass; and to ask your opposition to do likewise. Many thanks. Spence
